Thank you to all those who attended our first P & C meeting for 2019. We will send home more information in the coming weeks about canteen and the P & C.

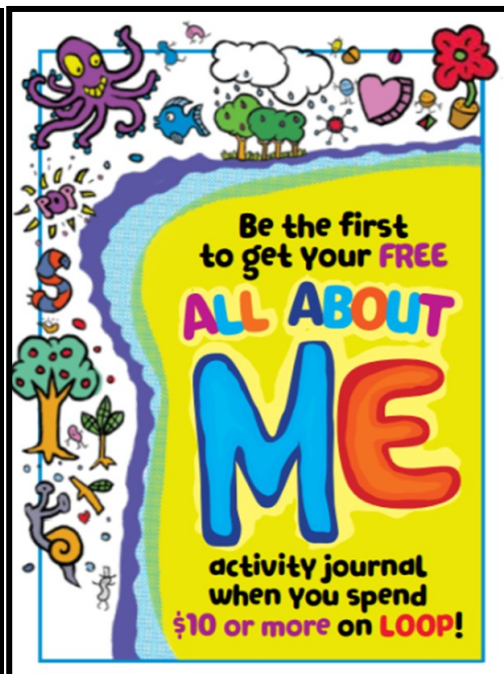
Book Club - Orders to be entered online by Friday 15th February 2019.
