The NSW Government is helping kids get active with the Active Kids program.

The Active Kids program provides two \$100 vouchers for parents, guardians and carers of school enrolled children to use towards registration and membership fees for sport and active recreation each year.

From 1 July 2019, parents, guardians and carers can apply for the second \$100 Active Kids voucher. Voucher one is valid January to December and Voucher two is valid July to December.

The vouchers may be used with an <u>approved Active Kids provider</u> for registration and membership costs for sport and active recreation activities.


